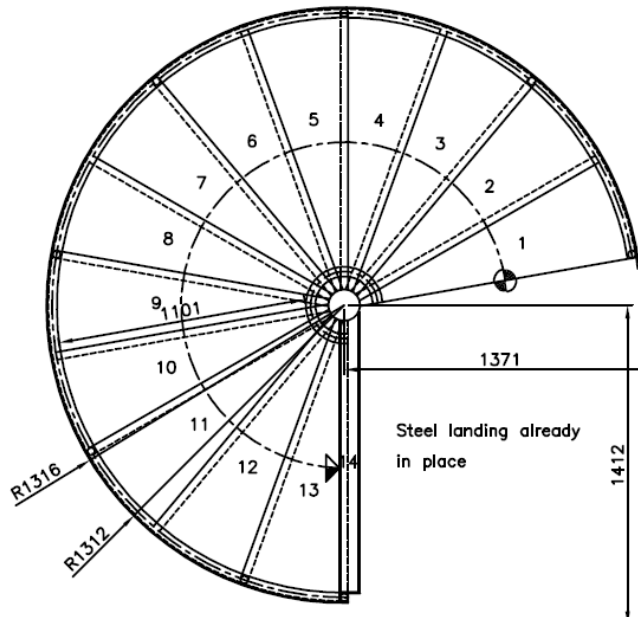


CASE STUDY - Bespoke Spiral Staircase - Wine Bar, London

Our customer for this project was refurbishing a unit for a well known Wine Bar chain in the BBC centre, West London. The plans showed the spiral staircase was going to be the first thing customers saw when entering the premises, so we had to create something a little special. Working with our client, we decided on a spiral with a stringer around the circumference of the spiral. This along with the stainless steel horizontal bars in the balustrade created a real 'sweep' to the spiral. We added a stainless steel handrail which we also attached to the centre column and matched the Oak treads to the flooring being installed throughout.
