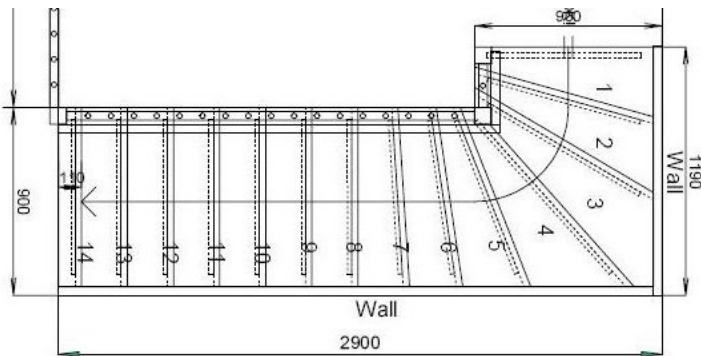


## CASE STUDY - Stepped Style Staircase - Southampton

The Client in this case study wanted to maintain a traditional feel for the staircase, to match the rest of the property, but at the same time wanted there to be a certain edge to the product, so it was not simply a normal staircase. The stepped design of this model, with the cut stringer placed slightly inside the edge of the treads on the visible side, combined with open risers, allows a modern feel to the staircase, whilst the choice of timber and the rest of the design work well to match the traditional aspects of the property.
