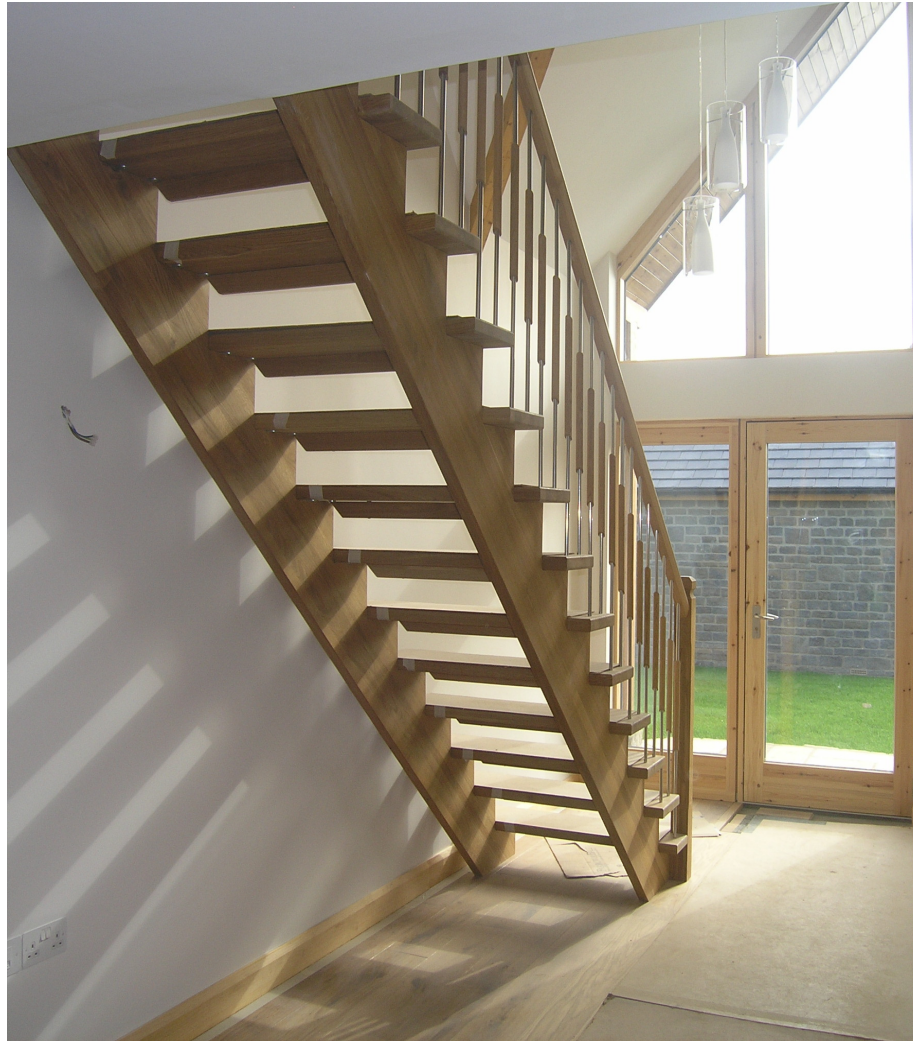


CASE STUDY – Stepped Style Staircase – Alveston, Gloucester

A refurbishment project in Alveston called for a modern, open-plan staircase; one that could be both a main feature of the hallway, but without darkening it. As can be seen in the photo below, the open riser effect combined with the large double windows facing the stair created a stunning look with the passage of light hardly hindered. The double stepped stringer look gave the staircase an individual quality, whilst the oak/steel spindles worked well with the white wall/wood look of the rest of the room.
