

CASE STUDY - Stepped Style Staircase - Brighton

We were approached to provide a simple, modern straight flight staircase for a new build development in Hove, Brighton. Clean lines were present throughout the property and this theme had to be continued with the staircase. Our client liked our 'stepped' style staircase as the cut stringer allowed the riser and going to be seen from the side of the staircase. The treads and handrail were produced in solid varnished oak to match the existing flooring and the stringers, spindles and newel posts were painted white in the factory to blend in with the surrounding walls. Landing balustrade was continued around the stairwell opening.

STRINGERS	-	42mm MDF / Pine / MDF – Stepped – painted white
SPINDLES	-	25mm diameter painted white
HANDRAIL	-	60 x 50mm - curved top (no. 7)
NEWEL POSTS	-	80 x 80 timber – painted white
FINISH	-	Varnished
