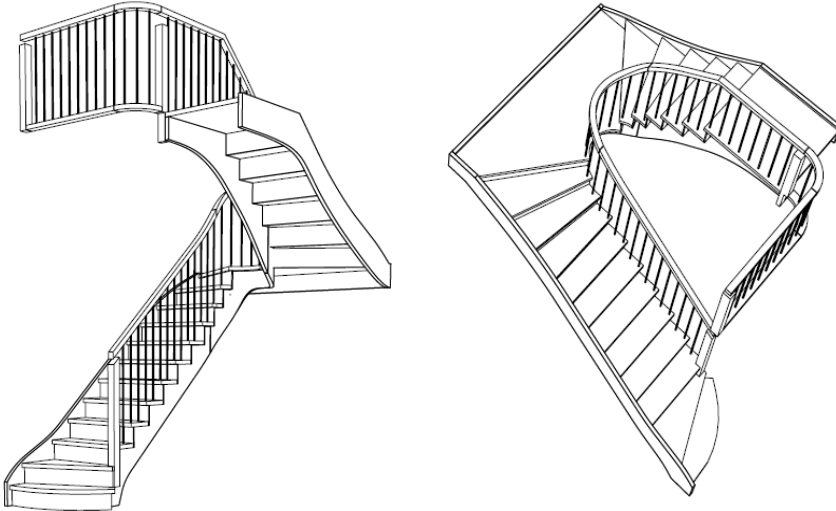


CASE STUDY – Stepped Style – Swavesey, Cambridge

Our customer was undertaking a complete new build in his plot of land in the village of Swavesey. The stairwell and floor to floor height was very large for a domestic staircase so we included a mid landing and a top landing platform. The theme of the entire house was Oak, so we priced a solid Oak staircase with stepped stringers on the internal side and closed risers. Our client handpicked the balustrade options from our range and decided upon spindle 20, handrail no. 7 and newel post 1.

NEWEL POSTS	-	80 x 80 Oak (no. 1)
FINISH	-	Varnished
