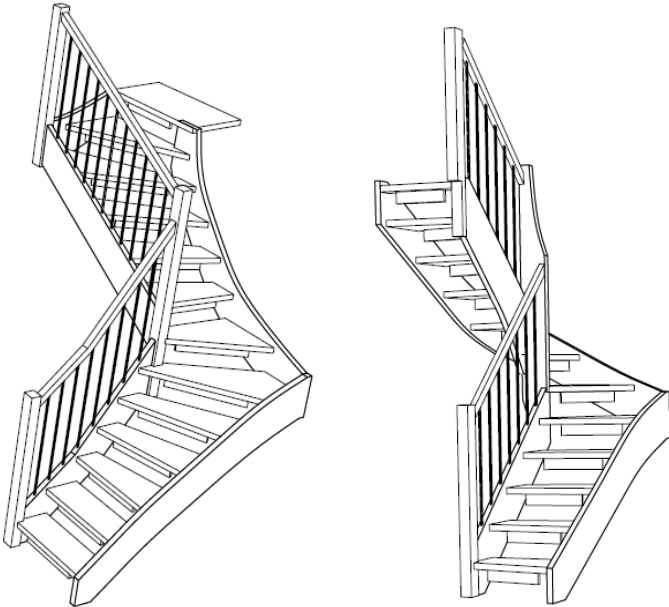


CASE STUDY - Traditional Style Staircase, Esher, Surrey

Our customer needed a ground to first and first to second floor staircase as part of his domestic refurbishment. The openings were very tight so each staircase had to have a reduced tread width and careful planning was required to ensure there was sufficient headroom on the lower staircase. Our customer selected a light Maple staircase with stainless steel spindles and open risers. Mini timber riser bars were included to ensure the gap between the treads didn't exceed 100mm
