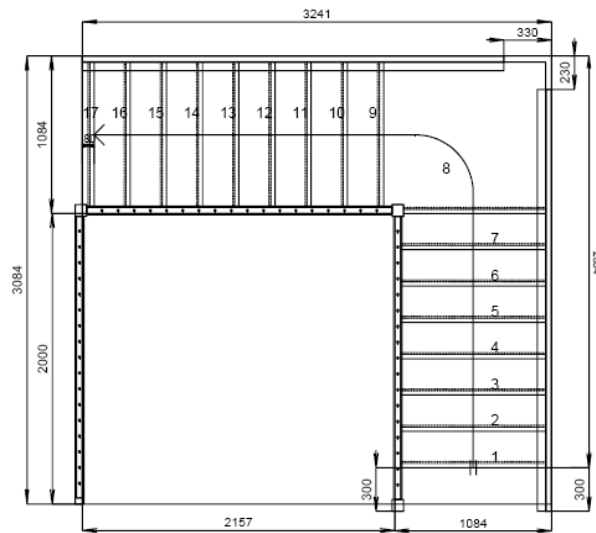


CASE STUDY - Traditional Style Staircase – Manston, Kent

Our client was refurbishing their office and production unit in Manston, Kent. They wanted a functional timber staircase that created a striking impression as their customers entered the building. The staircase was for 'Semi-public' usage so we had to ensure the risers were closed, the handrail was extended at the bottom of the stair, and that we had a square mid platform in place. Our client decided on a solid Beechwood staircase with simple clean newel posts and stainless steel spindles. A wall mounted handrail was included but is not shown in the photos.

FLOOR TO FLOOR HEIGHT	-	2953mm
RISERS	-	17 @ 173.7mm
GOING	-	250mm
TREAD WIDTH	-	1084mm
TREADS	-	42mm Solid Beech
STRINGERS	-	42mm Solid Beech
NEWEL POSTS	-	80 x 80mm Beech (no. 1 in range)
HANDRAIL	-	no. 1 – Solid Beechwood
MID LANDING	-	1200 x 1100mm at turn
