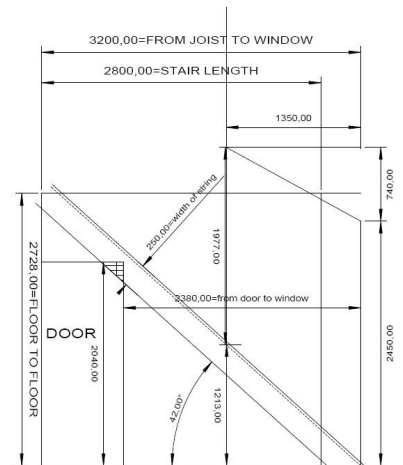
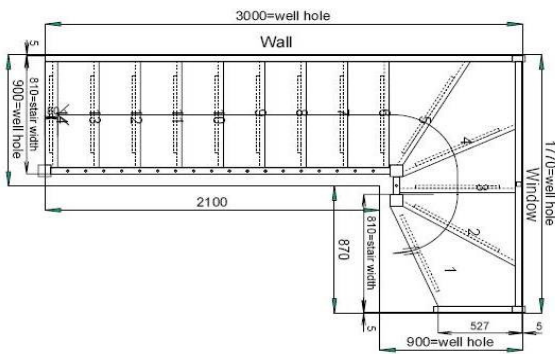


CASE STUDY - Traditional Style Staircase, Rickmansworth, Herts

Our customer needed a staircase at the end of a large, central hallway for their new build property. The hall was finished with a full-length glass window, so an impressive looking model was required as it would be fully visible from outside. The Traditional Style Staircase in Oiled Oak, with a customised arrangement of winder treads for the initial tight headroom turn, was the perfect solution, allowing the light to pass through into the hallway, whilst still protecting the window with a small run of external balustrade. The riser bars were customised by the customer from extra spindles we supplied.
