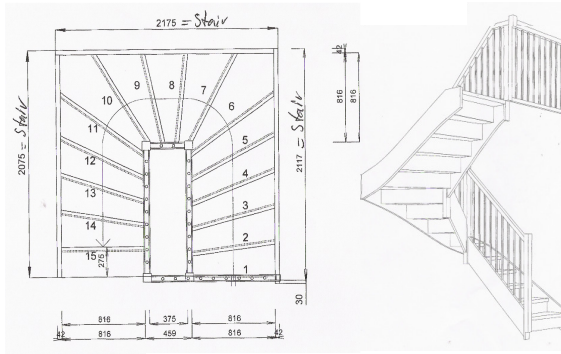
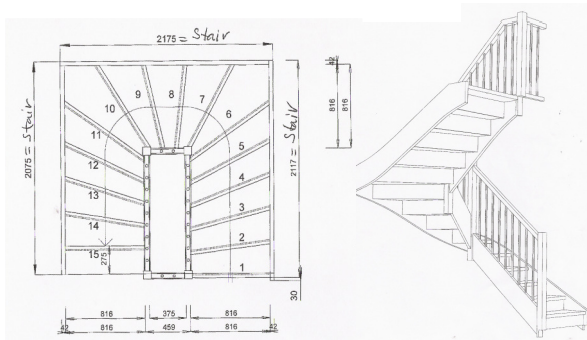


CASE STUDY – Traditional Style Staircase - Wimbledon

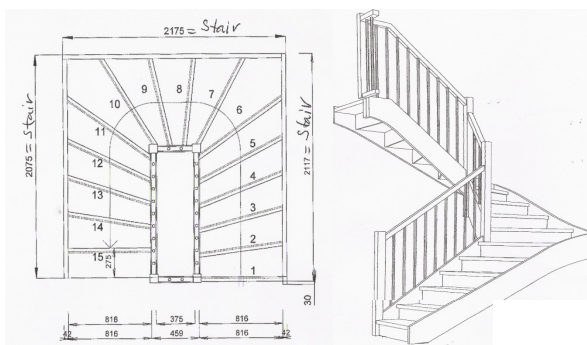
We were approached by a prestigious property developer to provide the staircases for two new town houses that were being built in Wimbledon. Each spanned three floors and they required 3 solid timber half turn staircases situated above one another for each property. The client wanted a simple traditional design as they were to be carpeted and painted on site. Each model was constructed in Pine and were dispatched from the factory with a primed undercoat. The client selected spindle no. 4, handrail no. 7 and newel post 1 from our range.

SPINDLES	- 25mm Ø Pine (no. 4 from range)
HANDRAIL	- 60 x 50mm with curved top (no. 7)
NEWEL POSTS	- 80 x 80 Pine (no. 1)
FINISH	- Primed for on site painting
