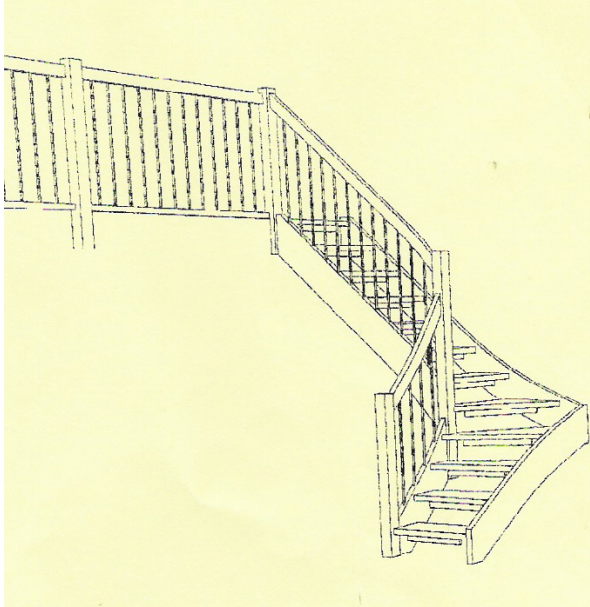


CASE STUDY - Domestic Extension – Camberley, Surrey

Our client was converting an out-building into a fully functional Annex for a family member to live in. After proposing several different options, our client settled on a solid beech staircase with open risers. We had to ensure it didn't take up too much space because of the size of the room so the staircase had a tread width of 700mm. Balustrade was made up from stainless steel spindles which were continued at first floor level.
