

CASE STUDY – WF Staircase –Lanarkshire

In this particular new build the client's main concern was to combine the traditional feel of the cottage, with a more modern open staircase. To accomplish this, the staircase itself was constructed from oak, thus preserving the traditional aspect of the cottage, with a glass balustrade at the top of the stair. Wall lights mounted above each tread, and open risers, all combined to create a well lit area with a stunning staircase elegantly sweeping down. For added effect a WF system was used, with a single wall stringer; thus creating the impression that the treads were suspended in mid-air.
