

## CASE STUDY - WF Staircase – Market Harborough, Leicestershire

Our client was constructing a new 'minimalist' property in Market Harborough and required a contemporary open staircase in Oak. They selected a quarter turn WF system with oiled oak treads, handrail and wall stringer. This unique system has open risers and no stringer on the open side. It is supported by stainless steel spindles that screw directly into a 160mm deep handrail. To emphasise the quarter turn the client opted for a curve to the internal handrail. 2600mm of matching landing balustrade was included.
