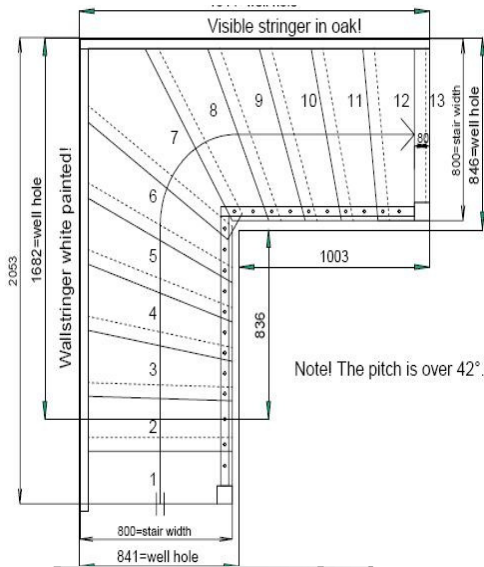


CASE STUDY - WF Staircase - Winchester, Hampshire

For this build the client really wanted an unusual looking staircase, but not overpowering to the room it was to be in. The WF style staircase, with its distinctive "hanging" tread design, made for the perfect option, with a design not often seen of treads seeming to be unsupported apart from the handrail. The choice of open risers meant the stair was not imposing, and the selection of Oak as the timber lent a degree of tradition to the arrangement, as well as nicely complementing the existing wooden flooring.

HANDRAIL	-	WF Oak Handrail
BALUSTRADE INFILL	-	13mm Diameter Stainless Steel Spindles
